



## AUSTIN AUTISM BIKE RIDE 2010

Sunday, April 11, 2010

Berry Springs County Park and Preserve

Enjoy a spring bike ride on beautiful country roads through picturesque Williamson County, followed by a delicious lunch. The Austin Autism Bike Ride 2010 benefits the Autism Society of Greater Austin (ASGA) and promotes bicycle safety and advocacy. ASGA, the local chapter of the Autism Society of America (ASA), is primarily a support group for families of children and adults on the autism spectrum. ASGA provides direct information and support to anyone affected or needing help in dealing with a recent diagnosis of an autism spectrum disorder or a problem that has surfaced with a child or adult that has already been diagnosed. As more and more children are being diagnosed everyday in the Austin area, the need for information, direction and compassion for these families grows every day. ASGA is a first step for a lot of bewildered families who do not know where else to get information on what they need to do next to help their child. In order to better provide help to these families, ASGA is attempting to not only raise money, but perhaps more importantly to raise awareness in our community of the challenges that these children and adults face each and every day.

**PLACE:** Berry Springs County Park and Preserve, 1801 CR 152, Georgetown, Texas. From I-35, take the Andice/Lake Georgetown (RM 2338 -Williams Dr.) exit #261A if coming from the south, or #262 from the north. Go east on RM 2338; turn left at the light (McDonald's is on the right) onto Austin Ave. The Georgetown High School Ninth Grade Campus is about a mile north on the right side of the street, immediately past Georgetown HS. Turn right just past the Ninth Grade Campus, onto CR 151. Follow CR 151, and turn left onto CR 152. Entry gate to Berry Springs County Park and Preserve, 1801 CR 152 will be on your left.

**TIME:** RIDE STARTS AT 9:00am with no riders leaving after 10am.

**ROUTES** are of approximately 2.5, 9, 20, and 41 miles, and 100K with START & FINISH at the Berry Springs County Park and Preserve. All routes pedal through moderately flat terrain interspersed with rolling hills on the eastern side of Williamson County. Riders must obey all traffic laws. Helmets must be worn. Rest stops will be available throughout the ride. SAG vehicles will be patrolling the routes to help with mechanical troubles and to pick up riders with any problems. Prior to the ride, have your bicycle checked for FREE at the Bicycle Sports Shop (for locations visit [www.bicyclesportshop.com](http://www.bicyclesportshop.com)). Please be prepared to handle your own flats and minor problems. Visit [www.austinautismbikeride.org](http://www.austinautismbikeride.org) for more information on maps.

**PLEASE NOTE: 2.5 MILE FAMILY RIDE WILL BE LIMITED TO THE FIRST 50 ENTRANTS. THE LONGER RIDES (9, 20 AND 41 MILES, 100K) WILL BE CAPPED AT THE FIRST 250 ENTRANTS.**

**PACKET PICK-UP** will be announced the first week of April on the ride website at [www.austinautismbikeride.org](http://www.austinautismbikeride.org). On ride day, packets may be picked up beginning at 8:00 a.m. at the Berry Springs County Park and Preserve.

**ENTRY FEE AND REGISTRATION FORM:** This ride will be a rain or shine event with no refunds. If the ride has to be cancelled due to dangerous weather, an announcement will be posted to the website
